### Key Holdings

1. Over-the-counter acid sale banned.
2. Free medical treatment for acid attack victims.
3. Minimum Rs. 3 lakh compensation within 15 days.

### Impact

Led to strict acid sale regulation and Section 326A/326B IPC.
